HOW TO READ GOD’S WORD

A plan to help you read the Bible through in approximate chronological order in one year.

1. Begin with prayer.
Before each reading pray for God to cleanse you from all sin (Heb. 10:22). Ask for the Holy Spirit to illumine your mind for understanding. The Psalmist’s prayer is helpful: “Open my eyes that I may see wonderful things in your law” (119:18).
2. Look for Christ.
Jesus began with Moses and all the prophets explaining to His disciples how the Scriptures spoke about Himself (Luke 24:27). There is not a word in the Bible that can be understood without Jesus Christ and His death, burial, resurrection and coming glory. May we see Jesus in all of His Word!
3. Keep on reading and meditating.
If you get behind in your reading (and you almost certainly will!), don’t give up. We need God’s Word most when we seem farthest from it. There is no substitute for reading the Bible. It gives us light for our daily life, and it alone gives true and lasting joy to our hearts (Psalm 119:105-112).
4. Conclude with prayer.
Each time we hear God speak to us, we need to respond with willing hearts to Him. In other words, “Do not merely listen to the word and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says” (Jas. 1:22). With the Psalmist, may we set our hearts on keeping God’s decrees to the very end (Psalm 119:112).

Let’s read through God’s Word together in the year 2006. NOTHING is more helpful and important for us than God’s wisdom and light for our lives! “For God, Who said, ‘Let light shine out of darkness,’ made His light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ” (2 Cor. 4:6).
